

LIFE ECOADAPT50

Co-Creation of Strategic Action for Climate Change Adaptation of Territories and Local Economies



LIFE eCOadapt50 aims to raise awareness and action in Climate Change Adaptation (CCA) at local level involving key stakeholders, mainly governments and economic actors from the agriculture-livestock, forestry, fisheries and tourism sectors.

The project learns from the LIFE-CLINOMICS experience in developing strategies for mobilizing local investments, articulating political and social agendas to transform the local economy around CCA and proposes a new model of long-term governance. The project foresees the full incorporation of the banking and insurance sector in the action, as a guarantee of the implementation of action plans.

Specific objectives

- Expanding the implementation of the Local Strategy for Adaptation to Climate Change and planning for CCA action.
- · Increasing resilience in the territories.
- Implementing actions and long-term investments.
- · Establishing stable governing bodies for CCA.

Key outcomes

LIFE eCOadapt50 identifies the vulnerability of 19 different territories of Catalonia (covering up to 60% of Catalonia's land and 906.378 of inhabitants) and determines actions to increase their resilience. 350 Local stakeholders receive training and support to become more resilient and to invest on CCA. The result is a coadaptation process that empowers local territories and stakeholders to better adapt to climate change challenges.
